The Applicant is in the process of finalizing plans for its proposed development in Collinsville, Illinois. Its initial plan which is subject to substantial modification includes the following. Fairmount Park will construct a casino near its paddock, thereby helping to immerse the casino patrons in the essence of race track operations. The addition of approximately 500 new employees to augment the 400 we currently employ, we will continue to attempt to match the racial mix of the surrounding community through our current affirmative action program. We expect to make the program even more robust after hiring a Director of Human Resources. We have contracted with the CPA firm of CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP to provide an independent projection of the gaming and admission receipt as well as financial statements. Those will be forwarded to the Illinois Gaming Board upon their completion.
