Bally's Chicago's temporary casino facility (estimated to open in 2023) will be located at the Medinah Temple at 600 N. Wabash Avenue, Chicago, IL 60611 and include a gaming floor, food & beverage offerings and administrative space. Bally's Chicago permanent casino resort (estimated to open in 2026) will be located on a 30-acre site at 777 W. Chicago Avenue, Chicago, IL 60610 and will include a gaming floor, hotel, restaurants, entertainment venue, exhibition space, structured parking and outdoor public green space along the Chicago River. Bally's Chicago anticipates employing approximately 3,000 people (including 65% minorities and 45% women). Bally's Chicago has a commitment to diversity with 25% minority ownership.

In terms of economic benefits to the community, the impacts will be significant. In addition to employment, the City of Chicago has estimated they will benefit on an annualized basis once the permanent facility reaches maturity at close to \$200 million when incorporating all gaming, hotel, sales, property, employment and various other taxes and revenue streams. Annual admissions at the permanent facility are estimated to be ~4 million and projected adjusted gross gaming receipts in excess of \$800 million at maturity.

Bally's Chicago's policy will be to promote equal employment opportunities through an ongoing positive program of practices.
